PROHIBITS DISCRIMINATION

IN EMPLOYMENT, EDUCATION, HOUSING, PUBLIC
ACCOMMODATION, LAW ENFORCEMENT OR PUBLIC SERVICE

BASED ON

religion, race, color, national origin, sex,
disability, age¹, marital status¹, height², weight²,
arrest record², genetic information², and
familial status³

Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for employment
must notify their employers in writing within 182 days.

*¹ Under the education article, age and marital status
are prohibited considerations for admissions only*

² in employment only

³ in housing only
